Summer Art Camps:

Art classes will be held in the Discovery Gallery Classroom at the C.M. Russell Museum and will have a cap of nine students and one instructor. There will be minimal sharing of art supplies. Hand washing will be required before and after class. Hand sanitizer will be available and frequent use will be encouraged.

Common Areas:

There will be a marked pathway through the museum in order to inform social distancing and minimize contact to ensure that guests can enjoy the museum.

Health Checks:

Each morning, all C.M. Russell Staff will perform a self-wellness check and will be asked to stay home if they have a fever or are presenting other symptoms of illness. We ask that parents do not send their children to class if they are showing any signs of illness such as fever or coughing.

All highly touched surfaces will be sanitized at scheduled times throughout the day. This includes tabletops, chairs, door handles, etc.

We realize that these modifications may be difficult for some children; our priority is to provide a safe environment in which children can have fun exploring the museum and creating their own artwork. We will do our best to make sure that summer art classes remain fun with a sense of normalcy in this time of COVID-19.
